



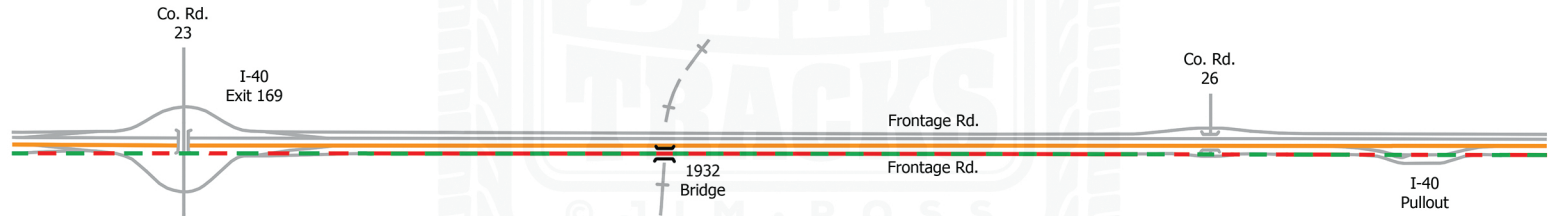
I-40

Note:
When I-40 was constructed, the orange route leaving Texola, Oklahoma was altered to follow the interstate entrance ramp (dark gray) beneath two bridges. The north I-40 frontage road did not exist at that time. The ramp and bridges were removed in the 1990s. See photo above.

Note:
The original route (green) stair-stepped into Texas from Texola, Oklahoma.

Alignments on this Map

Green/Red: Original (green) and first paved route (red).
Orange: Lanes added in the 1950s to create a 4-lane highway. The orange route later became eastbound I-40 westward from where the dashed orange line ends.
