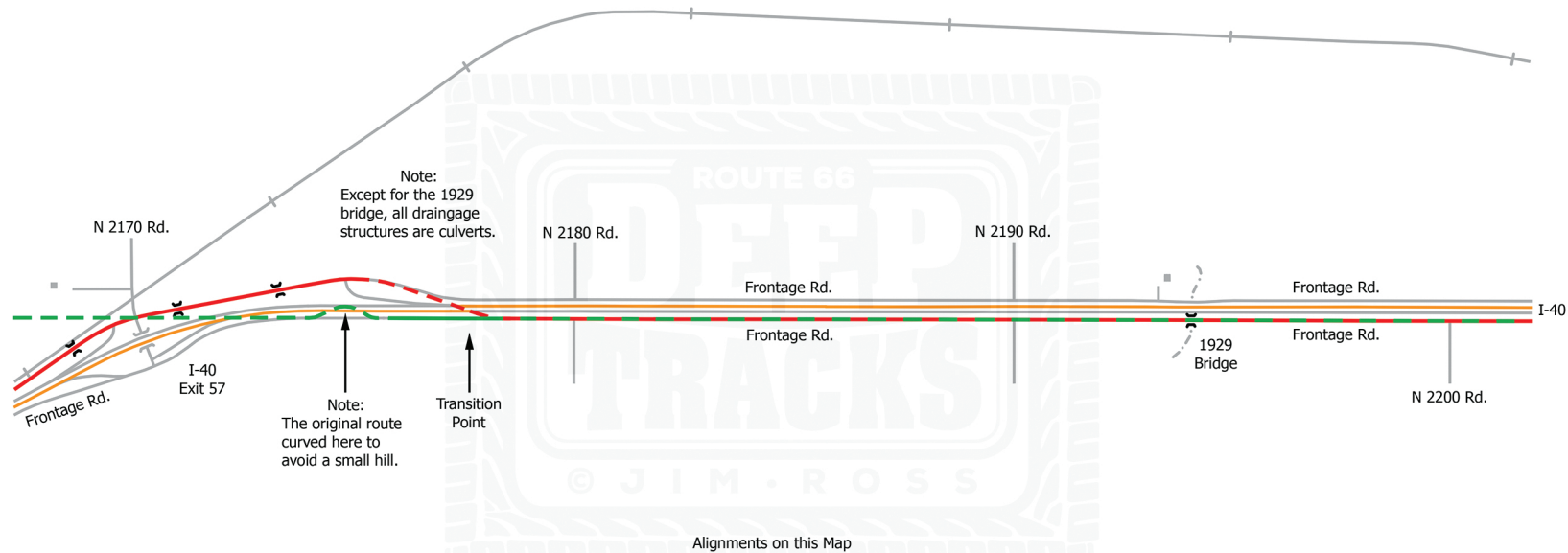


Between Weatherford (east)
and Foss (west)



Alignments on this Map

Green: Original route prior to paving.

Red: First paved alignment, completed in concrete in 1931.

Green/Red: Eastbound half of 4-lane US 66 from 1956-1958. It then became the I-40 frontage road.

Orange: Westbound half of 4-lane US 66 from 1956-1958 as far as the transition point (arrow), where it angled onto the red route. On the left side of the map, the orange route was the eastbound half of US 66 (following the future path of EB I-40) during the same years as far as the transition point, where it angled onto the green/red route. Once I-40 was completed in this area in 1958, US 66 was moved onto the interstate and the green/red and red only alignments became frontage roads.
