and Sayre (west)

Alignments on this Map

Green: Original route prior to paving, following the old Oklahoma postal route. The red route replaced this alignment in 1929.

Red (west of Pioneer Rd.): 1928 asphalt paving that extended 8 miles toward Sayre (completed in 1929). East of Pioneer Rd., existing paved city streets were resurfaced with concrete in 1931. The red route bypassed the green route from Elk City to Sayre.

Orange: Lanes added in 1958, creating a divided 4-lane alignment as far west as the US 283 junction at Sayre (Map 109).

Note:
From this point, mapping will continue along the red route to Sayre (Map 109), and then return here to map the 1926-1928 green route to the same location.
