Note on Alignments:

The original route (green) was paved here in 1933 (red). In 1959, lanes were added (orange), creating a 4-lane highway. These lanes first appear on the 1960 state highway map.

Note on Ozark Trails:

The Ozark Trails was a close companion to US 66 in parts of Oklahoma, running concurrently in several locations. Here, S 4300, and E 330, Rds. were OT alignments, but never carried US 66 traffic. Route 66 as depicted, while not paved until 1933, was graded in 1926 under Federal Aid Projects 185-A and 185-C.
