and Gray Summit (west)

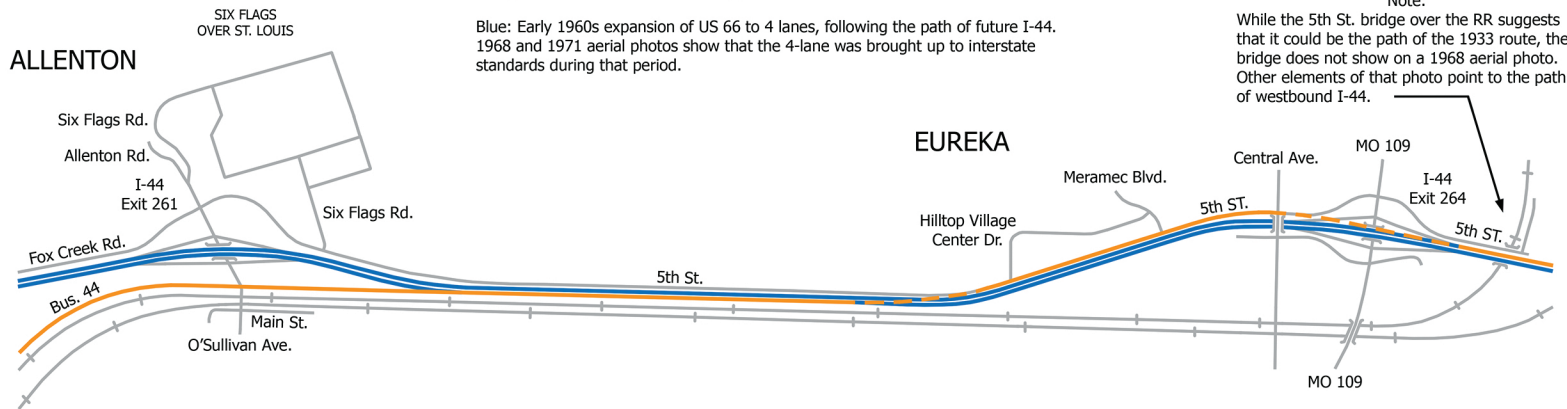
Alignments on this Map

Green/Red: Continuation of the original 1926-1933 alignment along Manchester Rd.

Orange: Continuation of the 1933 upgrade route.

Blue: Early 1960s expansion of US 66 to 4 lanes, following the path of future I-44. 1968 and 1971 aerial photos show that the 4-lane was brought up to interstate standards during that period.

Note:
The distance between the green/red and orange routes was compressed to fit both on the map. Actual distance between them on this end of the map is 5.5 miles.



Note:
While the 5th St. bridge over the RR suggests that it could be the path of the 1933 route, the bridge does not show on a 1968 aerial photo. Other elements of that photo point to the path of westbound I-44.
