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Note on Bridges:

Between 1929-1931, a series of short timber bridges were built on the new alignment (red) between the Mountain Springs Rd. exit (previous map) and Daggett. Of the 137 built, the majority survive. Two appearing on 1953 aerial photos were later removed (Maps 32 & 37), and two others were lost due to I-40 construction (Map 38). Note: this is reflected in the Route 66 Bridge database, which lists 133 bridges rather than 137.

In the mid-2000s, flooding damaged or destroyed a number of these structures, yet this remarkable collection of vintage spans remains one of the marvels of the route.
