

Note on Alignments:

As it was with the loop through Goffs to Essex, the early route (green), was improved with Macadam (thin asphalt) westward from Essex to Amboy between 1926 and 1931, when it was replaced by the uniformly paved realignment (red).

The dashed gray line represents a previous but still post-66 era paved connection to the red route.

Note:
Other than the RR viaduct, all drainage structures on this map are timber bridges built between 1929 and 1931.
