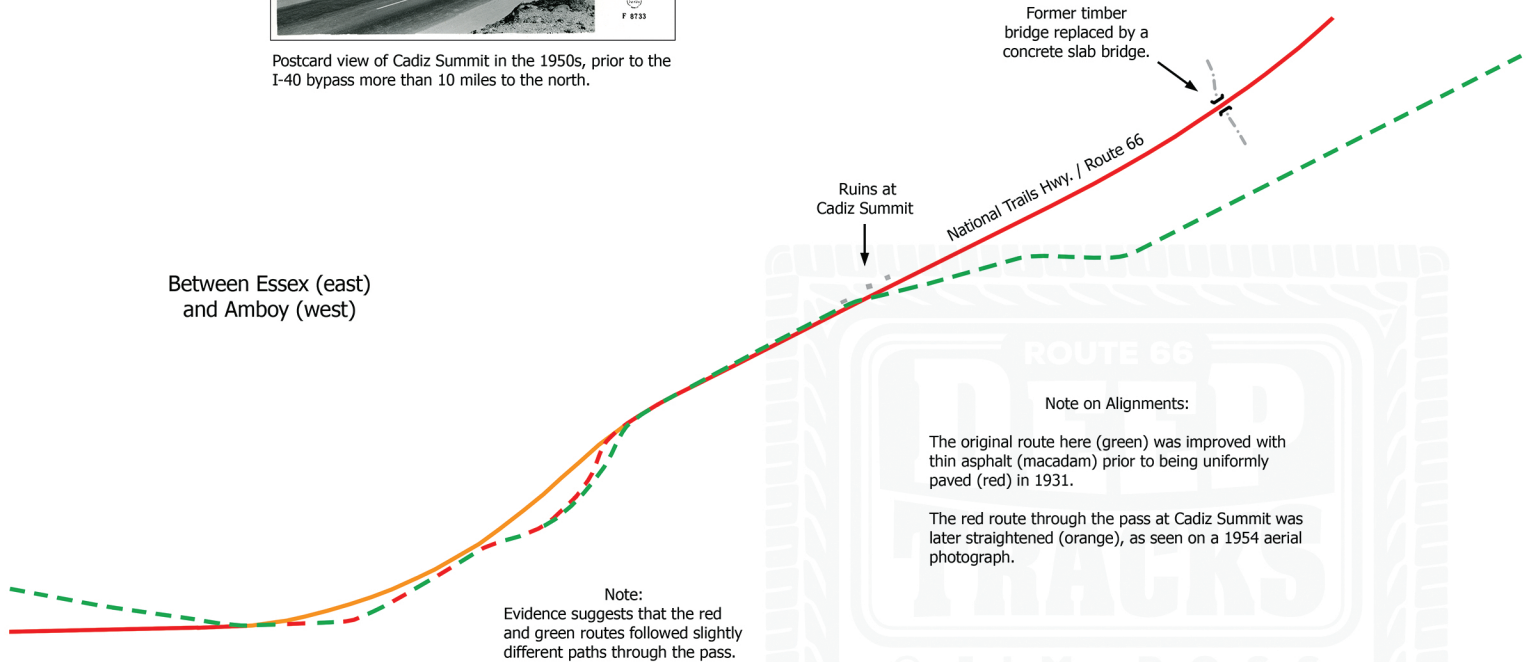

Note on Alignments:

The original route here (green) was improved with thin asphalt (macadam) prior to being uniformly paved (red) in 1931.

The red route through the pass at Cadiz Summit was later straightened (orange), as seen on a 1954 aerial photograph.

Note:
Evidence suggests that the red
and green routes followed slightly
different paths through the pass.

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
