Note on RR Crossing at Cicero Avenue:

The original green/red alignment on Ogden Ave. crossed the RR via two 90-degree turns at Cicero Ave. In 1938, a massive overhead was built (orange, and photo at left), consisting of two large steel truss spans and 22 additional mixed truss spans that separated Ogden Ave./US 66 from the tracks. A portion of the newly-elevated Ogden Ave. on the east side of Cicero Ave. was divided. Traffic on Cicero Ave. passed under a trestle (visible in photo). In 1999, the bridges were removed, and the road reconfigured as depicted (gray).
