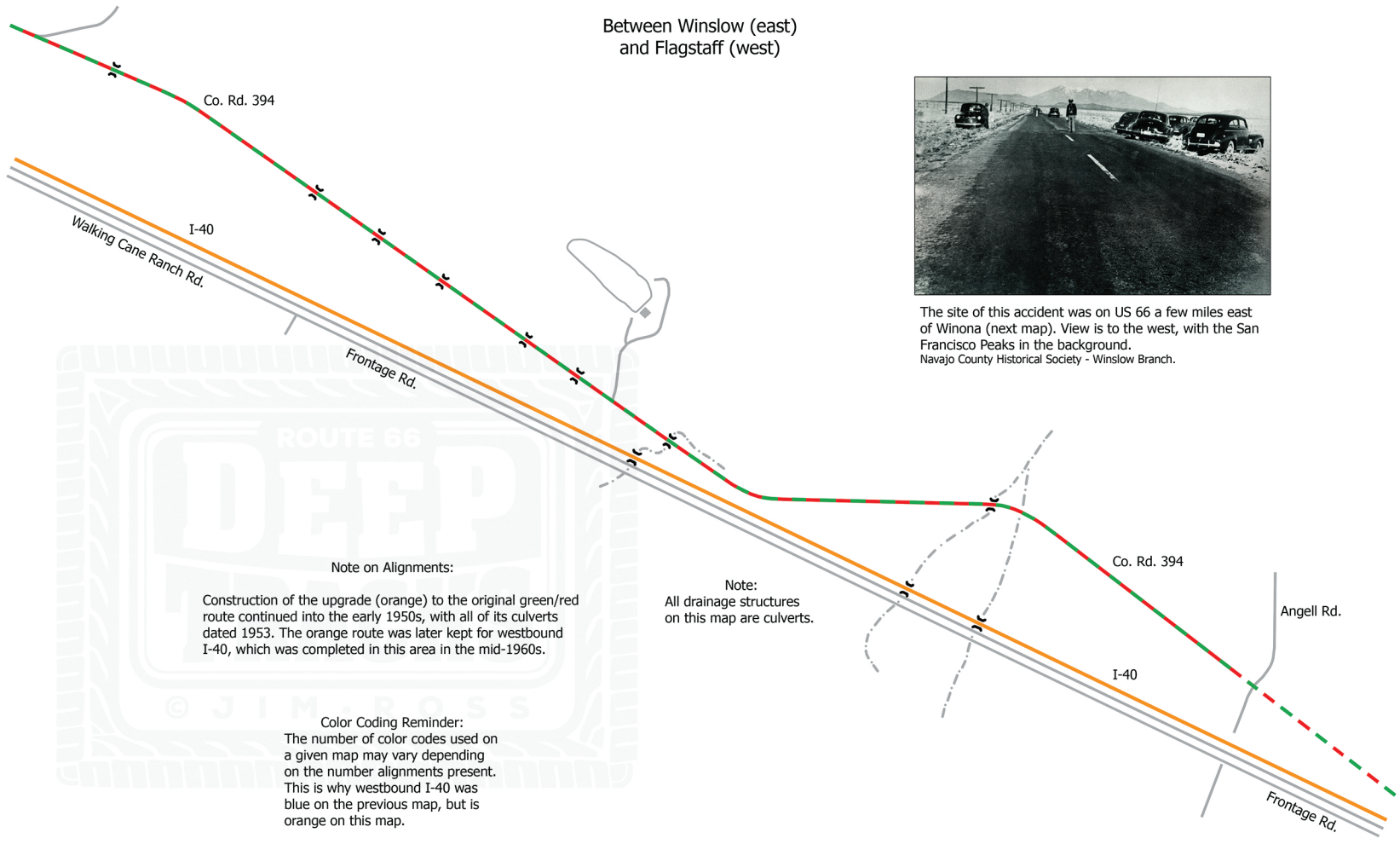


Between Winslow (east)

Note on Alignments:

Construction of the upgrade (orange) to the original green/red route continued into the early 1950s, with all of its culverts dated 1953. The orange route was later kept for westbound I-40, which was completed in this area in the mid-1960s.

Color Coding Reminder:

The number of color codes used on a given map may vary depending on the number alignments present. This is why westbound I-40 was blue on the previous map, but is orange on this map.

Note:

All drainage structures on this map are culverts.
