



Note on Alignments:

The orange 2-lane upgrade alignment was built in the 1940s, replacing the original green/red 2-lane, which was excavated. In the 1950s, lanes were added (blue) to create a 4-lane highway.

Note:

A 1974 aerial photo reveals that I-55 in the area of this map was not yet built. When it was constructed, the eastbound lanes (gray) were aligned slightly offset from the westbound half of the 4-lane (orange), extending the distance between the interstate and the service road (blue).
