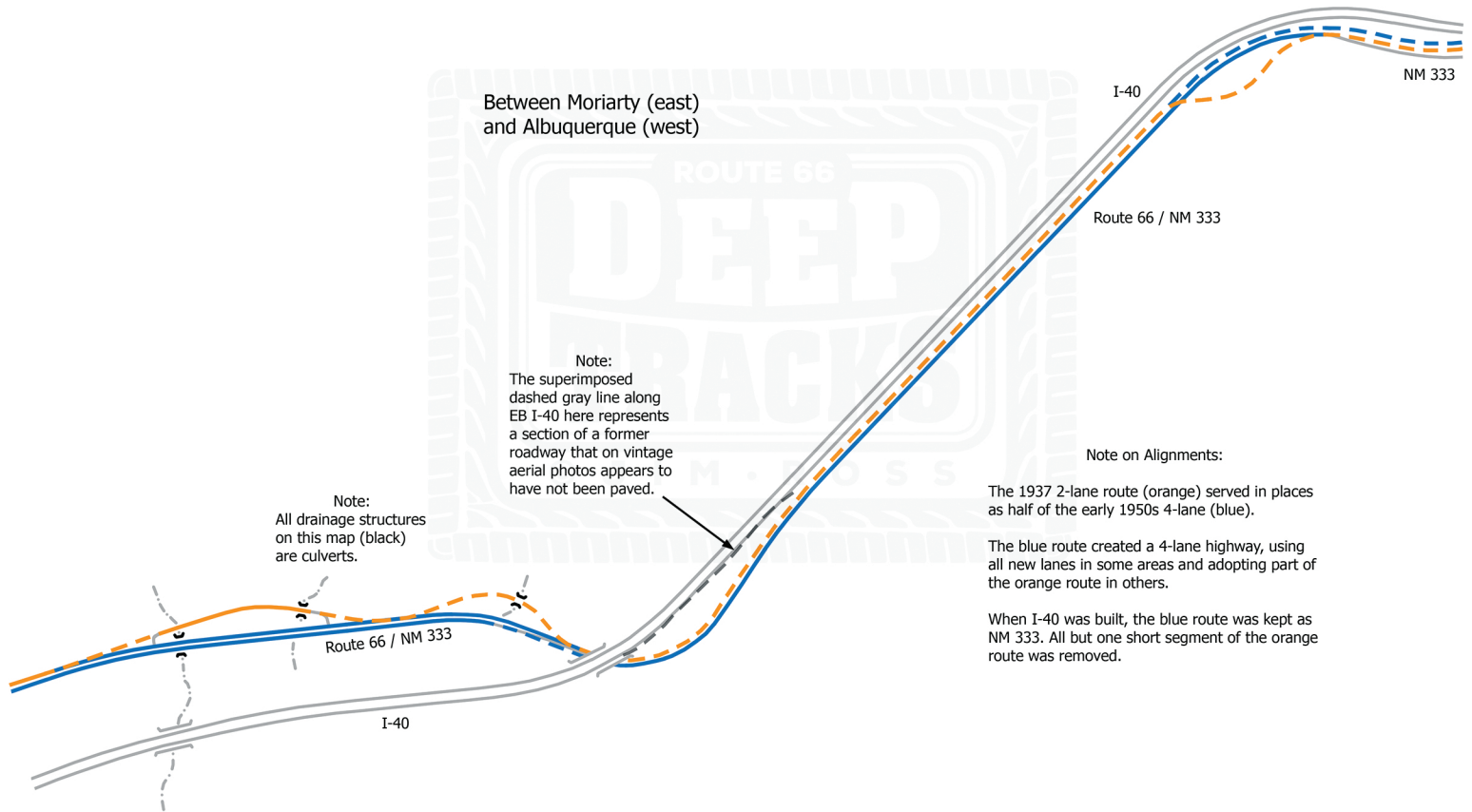


Between Moriarty (east)

aerial photos appears to
have not been paved.

Note on Alignments:

The 1937 2-lane route (orange) served in places
as half of the early 1950s 4-lane (blue).

The blue route created a 4-lane highway, using
all new lanes in some areas and adopting part of
the orange route in others.

When I-40 was built, the blue route was kept as
NM 333. All but one short segment of the orange
route was removed.
