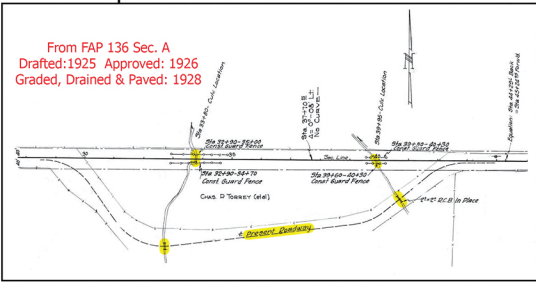

Example of how the early, unimproved roadway often went around terrain obstacles.

Alignments on this Map

Green: Original route, which involves two short loops that were bypassed when US 66 was paved in this area in 1928.

Red: 1928 first paved alignment, plans for which were developed in 1925. Such time gaps between project plans and construction were often due to funding issues.

Orange: 1984 upgrade to the first paved alignment. Note that the orange route from Depew (Map 41) westward to its ending above on this map only carried US 66 traffic for about one year before the route was decertified in Oklahoma. The Camp Creek Bridge built for the orange route remains in use as of 2022.
