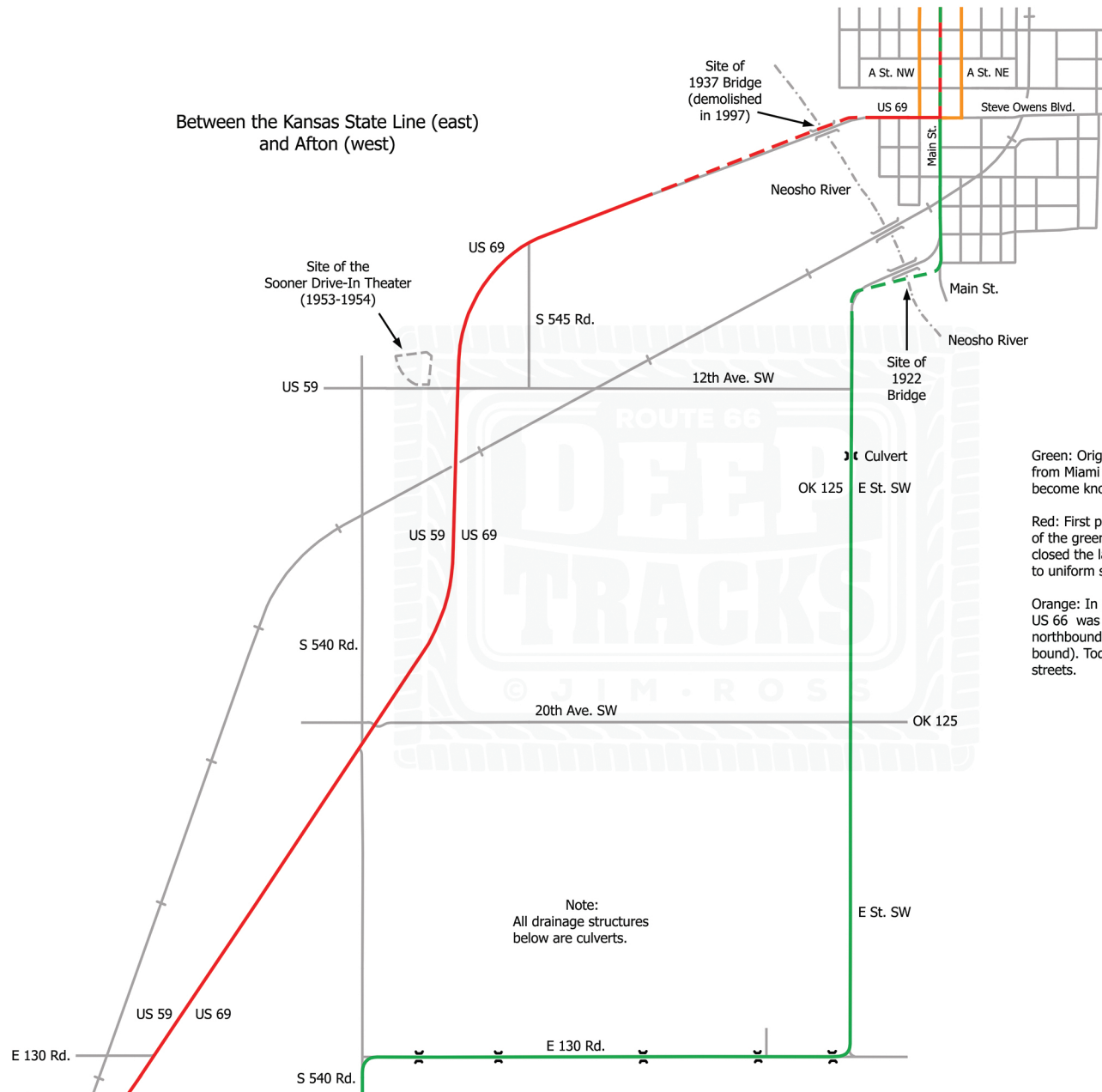


Between the Kansas State Line (east)

Alignments on this Map

Green: Original alignment, paved 9-foot wide from Miami to Afton (Map 8) in 1922, it has become known as the "sidewalk highway."

Red: First paved alignment. The 1937 bypass of the green route between Miami and Afton closed the last gap in Oklahoma not yet paved to uniform standards.

Orange: In 1968, to alleviate traffic congestion, US 66 was moved onto A St. NE (one-way northbound), and A St. NW (one-way southbound). Today, US 69 remains on the one-way streets.
