Alignments on this Map

- Green/Red: Original pathway of IL 4 and US 66.
- Orange: Upgrade 2-lane alignment.
- Blue: Lanes added in the 1950s to create a 4-lane highway.

Note: As established, US 66 initially adopted the already-paved IL 4. This was replaced with an offset alignment (orange) in the 1940s, which included 2-lane bypasses around the towns. In the mid-1950s, lanes were added (blue) to create a 4-lane highway. The eastbound half of the 4-lane on this map was partially removed subsequent to interstate construction (dashed blue line). I-55 construction got underway in this area in 1974.
