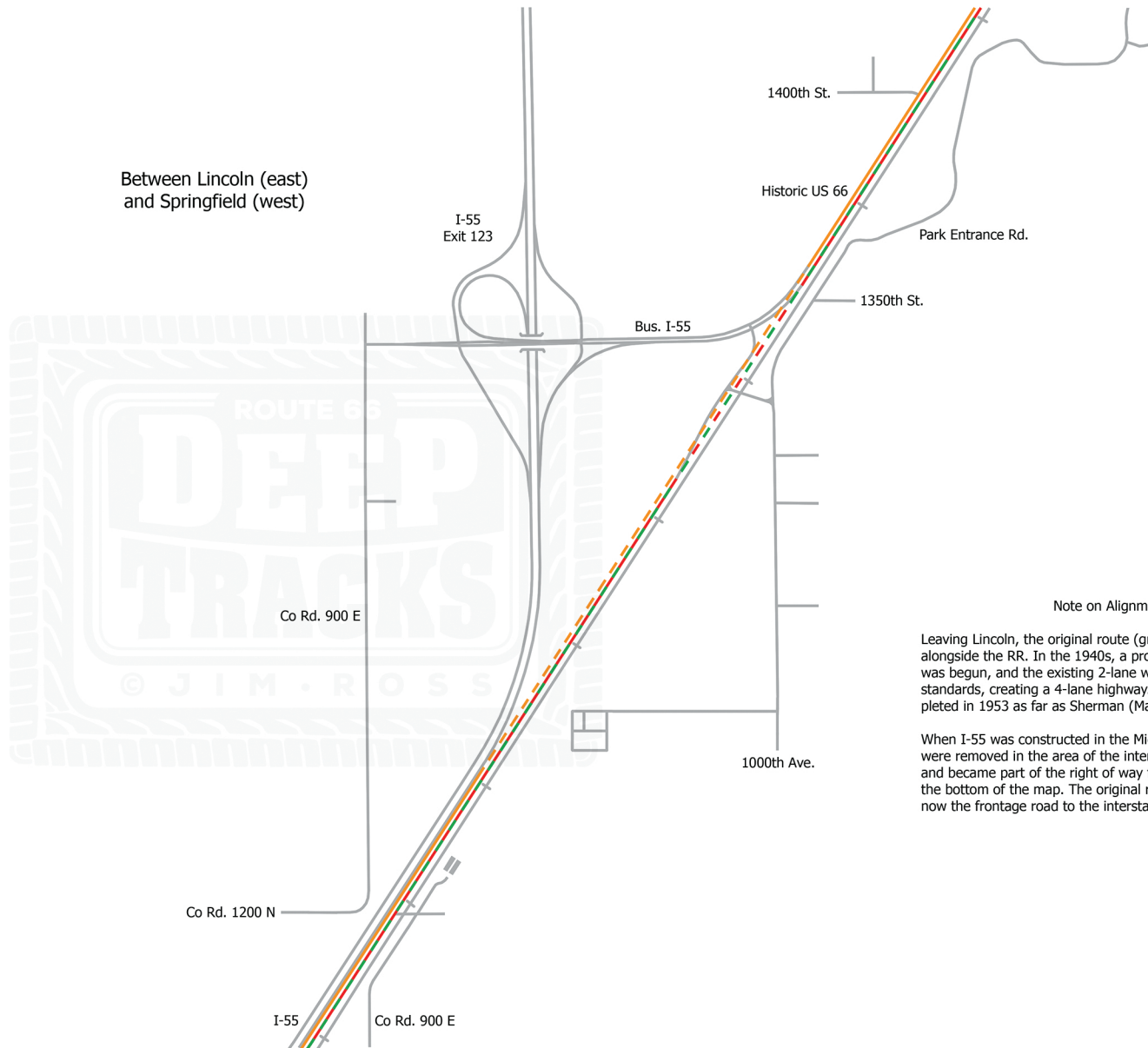


Between Lincoln (east)  
and Springfield (west)



**Note on Alignments:**

Leaving Lincoln, the original route (green/red) continued alongside the RR. In the 1940s, a project to add lanes (orange) was begun, and the existing 2-lane was brought up to current standards, creating a 4-lane highway. This project was completed in 1953 as far as Sherman (Map 60).

When I-55 was constructed in the Mid-1970s, the orange lanes were removed in the area of the interchange (dashed lines), and became part of the right of way for eastbound I-55 near the bottom of the map. The original route there (green/red) is now the frontage road to the interstate.
