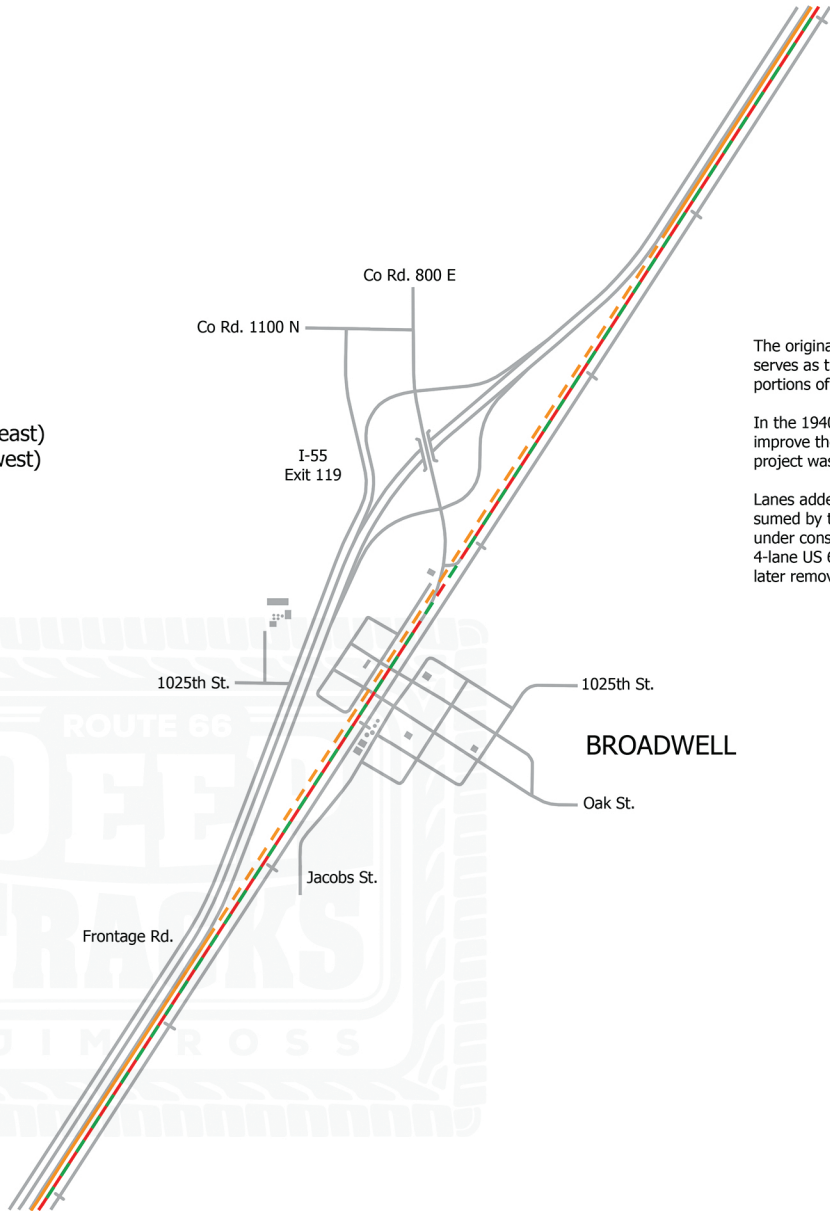


Between Lincoln (east)  
and Springfield (west)



**Note on Alignments:**

The original route (green/red) continues along the RR and serves as the frontage road for I-55 at the top and bottom portions of the map. This was the path of old IL 4.

In the 1940s, a project began to add lanes (orange), and improve the existing 2-lane, creating a 4-lane highway. This project was completed in 1953.

Lanes added to create the 4-lane (orange) were later consumed by the eastbound right of way for I-55, which was under construction here in 1973. The westbound half of 4-lane US 66 through Broadwell (dashed orange line) was later removed.
