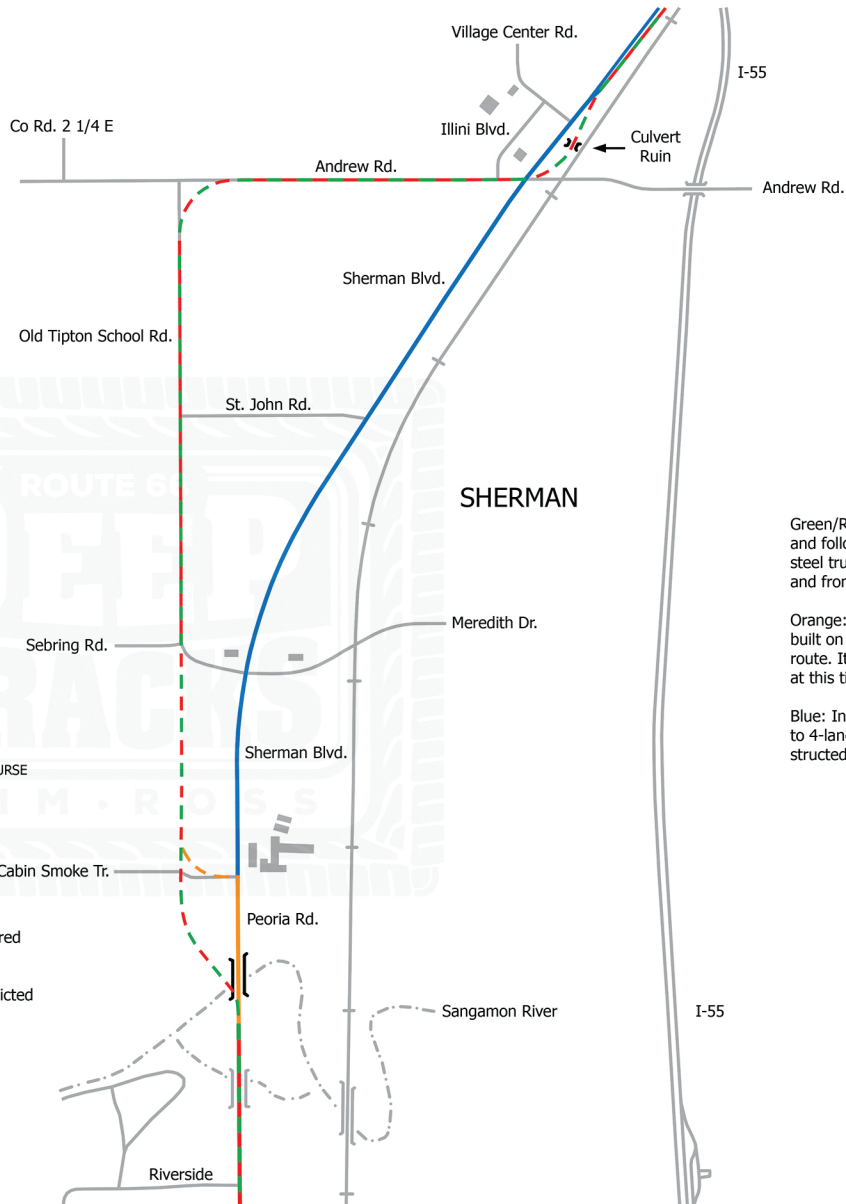


Between Lincoln (east)  
and Springfield (west)



Alignments on this Map

Green/Red: Original IL 4/US 66 curved onto Andrew Rd. and followed Old Tipton School Rd. to an early 1900s steel truss bridge on the Sangamon River (not depicted) and from there into Springfield.

Orange: A new 2-lane bridge with wide shoulders was built on the river in 1936, causing a realignment of the route. It is likely that the Blue route was already planned at this time.

Blue: In place by 1942, Sherman Blvd. was later widened to 4-lanes. The 1936 Sangamon River Bridge was reconstructed and widened in 1987.

Note:
