

Alignments on this Map

Green/Red: Original and first paved route. A 1930 USGS Topo Map depicts the hard turn to the west on Sandhill road before angling southwest back onto Peoria. From there it continued westbound past the fairgrounds to a south turn on 9th St.

Note: When US 66 was designated, original IL 4 followed Peoria along the east side of the fairgrounds. IL 4 was relocated to Taintor Rd. and 5th St. in 1932. US 66 never followed this alignment.

Orange: Realignment to eliminate the hard turn on Sandhill Rd. This was in place by 1942 and was a 4-lane roadway by 1946.

Blue: Represents the 1939 4-lane bypass route (completed by 1942), which became the mainline route in 1949.
