

Alignments on this Map

Green/Red: Original and first paved route, which follows Hwy. OO except for the area east of I-44 Exit 96. Note: When the 4-lane orange route was constructed, crossovers were included for the green/red alignment at each end of the loop below future I-44 Exit 96 to keep it open to traffic.

Orange: Lanes added in the 1950s to create a 4-lane highway. In the mid-1970s, the orange route east of I-44 Exit 96 was adopted by the interstate; west of Exit 96, I-44 adopted part of the orange route and added new lanes where needed (gray). The green/red route then became the interstate service road on the majority of this map.
