← 1926-1930 IL 4 Temporary Route

Green/Red: Follows the original path of IL 4. This was a Temporary route, designated to carry US 66 traffic until a permanent 2-lane alignment was completed along the corridor of future I-55.

Post-1930 Alignments →

Orange: The permanent 2-lane route between Springfield and Staunton continues to follow the path of future westbound I-55.

Blue: Lanes added to create a 4-lane highway in the 1950s follow Reichert Rd., which also serves as the west frontage road to I-55.

Note:
I-55 was under construction in this area in 1971.
