Turquoise: Established as "City" US 66 when the 1933 mainline route was relocated in 1936 from the Municipal-MacArthur Bridge alignment downtown to the Chain of Rocks Bridge route (Map 9).

The "City" route extended from Chain of Rocks Bridge (Map 9) southward via Riverview, Broadway, Calvary, Florissant, 13th, and Tucker to a junction with the 1933 route at Hickory downtown (Map 4) and continued from there along the former 1933 mainline all the way to the junction with the Chain of Rocks Bridge alignment at US 67/Kirkwood Rd. (Map 6).

The portion of the "City" route from the Chain of Rocks Bridge to the connection with the 1933 route at Hickory downtown was in use from 1936-1963. The portion that continued along the former 1933 route on Gravois, Chippewa, and Watson Rd. was in use until 1956, at which time it once again became the mainline route.

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
