← 1926-1930 IL 4 Temporary Route

Green/Red: Continues to follow the original path of IL 4, which was already paved when adopted by US 66.

Post-1930 Alignments →

Orange: The permanent 2-lane route here initially follows a path just to the west of the I-55 frontage road (dashed orange line) until angling back onto the frontage road pathway on the south side of I-55 Exit 63.

Blue: Lanes added to create a 4-lane highway in the 1950s following the path of westbound I-55 as well as the west I-55 frontage road (upper part of the map). Creating 4 new lanes in this area eliminated the offset orange alignment.
