

Alignments on this Map

Green/Red: Original and first paved route. Note that prior to the 1934 construction of the RR viaduct at the east end of Central Ave. (red route), US 66 followed the dog-leg on River St. (green).

Orange: 1950s upgrade to the green/red route on the right side of the map; 1937 upgrade to the green/red alignment on the left side of the map (Central Ave.).

Turquoise: Alternate US 66, implemented following completion of 1931 paving along "V" to what was then US 71 (Garrison Ave.). The Alternate route is labeled as such on the state highway map until 1964.

Note: Central Avenue's westward extension (gray--now Bus. I-49) from today's I-49 Exit 53 was under construction in 1977, after US 66 was removed from Missouri's highway system.
