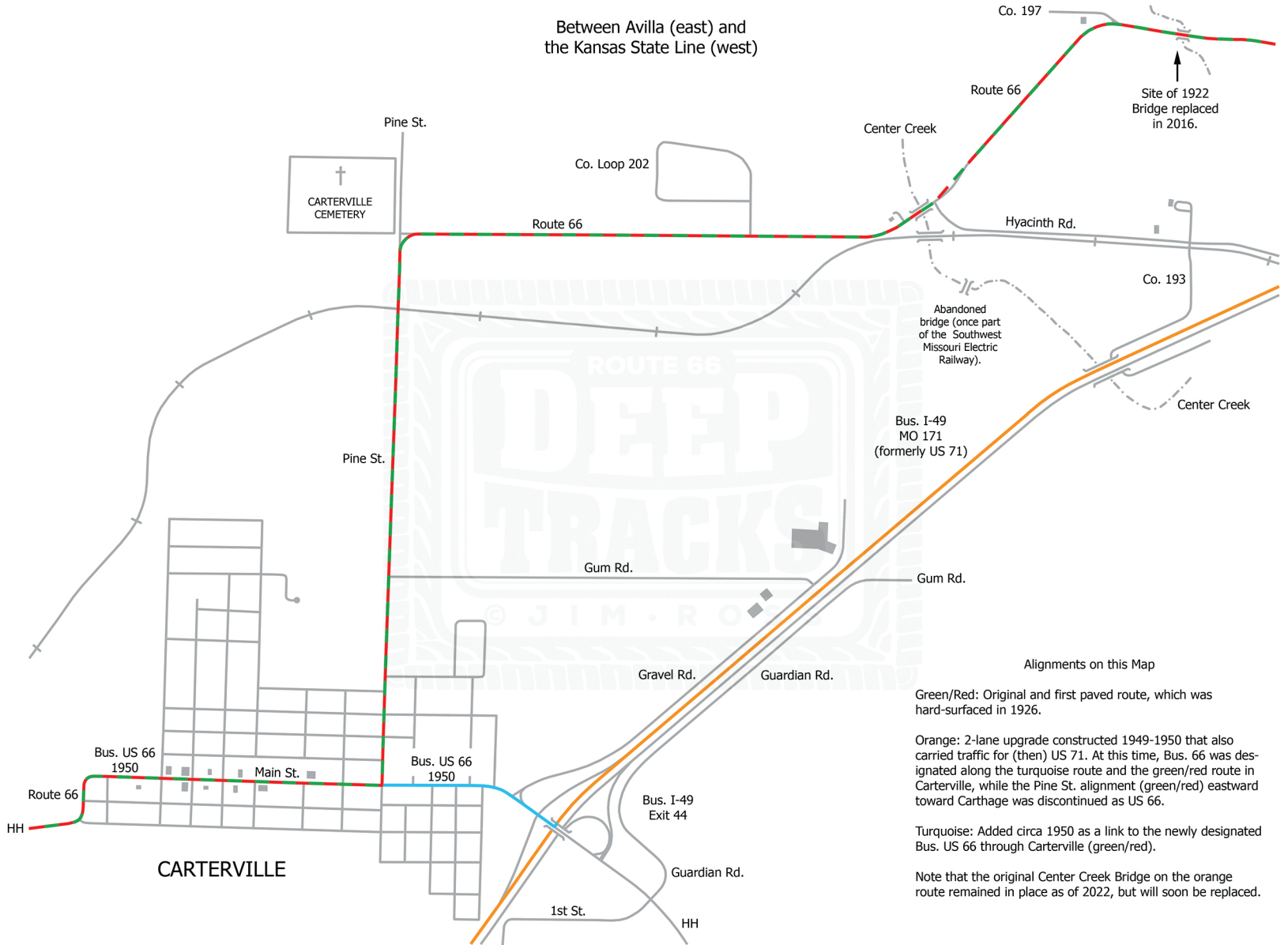


Between Avilla (east) and the Kansas State Line (west)



Alignments on this Map

Green/Red: Original and first paved route, which was hard-surfaced in 1926.

Orange: 2-lane upgrade constructed 1949-1950 that also carried traffic for (then) US 71. At this time, Bus. 66 was designated along the turquoise route and the green/red route in Carterville, while the Pine St. alignment (green/red) eastward toward Carthage was discontinued as US 66.

Turquoise: Added circa 1950 as a link to the newly designated Bus. US 66 through Carterville (green/red).

Note that the original Center Creek Bridge on the orange route remained in place as of 2022, but will soon be replaced.
