



Alignments on this Map

Magenta: This is the 4th mainline alignment on the Missouri side of the river, established when the route was moved to the Chain of Rocks Bridge from the Municipal-MacArthur Bridge in 1936. In 1956, this route became "Bypass" US 66 when the mainline route was moved to the MLK-Veterans Bridge in downtown St. Louis. The "Bypass" route designation was removed in 1965.

Note that the Chain of Rocks Bridge alignment was the 3rd mainline route on the Illinois side of the river. This is because there were two different mainline routes originating from the Municipal-MacArthur Bridge on the Missouri side, and only one connecting to that bridge on the Illinois side.

Turquoise: "City" US 66: Established when the mainline route moved from the Municipal-MacArthur Bridge in downtown St. Louis (Map 1) to the Chain of Rocks Bridge (this map) in 1936.
